About Sarasota Opera

Sarasota Opera, which owns its 1926 historic theater, renovated in 2008, produces a winter festival season with four operas in repertory from January to March, and a fall season of varying size. Throughout both seasons, Sarasota Opera offers additional special events and concerts.

Purpose of Position

With five operas a year complete with soloists, understudies, chorus and supernumeraries, our Costume Shop staff is always very busy. Volunteer stitchers assist the costume staff with basic hand sewing, such as buttons, hems, labels, snaps, and trim appliqués. Volunteers also do embroidery, fringe work, and beading.
