Background Screening:	Selected candidates must pass a level two background screening as required by the State of Florida before the start of their internship. Screening will be paid for by Sarasota Opera.
What You'll Learn:	The successful candidate will gain firsthand knowledge of how a professional opera company produces and performs an opera; and how it works with local youth through hands-on arts programming. Duties may include but are not limited to: - Work with directors, stage managers, and other members of Sarasota Opera's professional staff in varying capacities on the Youth Opera production of <i>Rootabaga Country</i> and the mainstage production of Humperdinck's <i>Hansel and Gretel</i>. - Provide administrative support for the Youth Opera Coordinator - Lead youths in daily activities such as acting games and rehearsal review - Assist with daily check-in and check-out activities - Assist with the planning and set up of parties and special events - Supervise and monitor the health and well-being of singers - Other duties as assigned While there are certain tasks the Intern will need to perform, we strive to have our interns make the most of their experience and are open to discussing more responsibilities and opportunities that will enrich their experience at Sarasota Opera to aid in their learning.
Knowledge & Skills:	The successful candidate will be a self-motivated team player who is detail-oriented, has great time management skills, and is comfortable working with children aged eight to eighteen. Previous experience or an interest in the performing arts is highly desirable. Applicants should be enrolled in university or graduates seeking experience in the field.
